Right to Refuse Vaccination

Whereas, mandatory vaccination is the same as mandatory medication;

Whereas there is a profound need for non-biased and accurate research about the definition of "herd immunity";

Whereas the separation between an individual and his or her government/employer is at the level of his or her skin;

Whereas there is a great need for educating physicians that vaccines cause harm and that one size fits all vaccination care is no better and no different than one size fits all dosing of medication;

Whereas there is medical research bias in research about problems associated with vaccines;

Whereas public health is more than high vaccination rates and low infection rates of a small subset of infectious diseases;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that all citizens:

Retain the right to refuse vaccination;

Have the right to have access to medical care even if they do not want to be injected with vaccines;

Will not be required to be vaccinated in order to retain employment (healthcare, paramedics, police, etc), or participate in higher education (college, graduate schools, etc);

Will not be required to have vaccines in exchange for a tax-payer funded public education;

Parents must retain the right to decide what is injected into the body of their child;

Adults must retain the right to decide what is injected into their body;

Demand fairness in representation in the media about the problems associated with vaccines; and

Demand fairness in research regarding side effect, illnesses and complications associated with vaccines and elimination of research bias.

Be it resolved that the 2012 Health Freedom Congress has considered the following resolutions and hereby adopts the health freedom principles embodied in the resolutions and offers the support of the member organizations to the extent determined by each organization's governing principles. *
