Letter from the President Rosanne Lindsay

Dear Friends of Health Freedom:

As president of the Board of the National Health Freedom Coalition (NHFC), I want to honor your important work and thank you, again, for your generous, continuing support.

As you may know from our eblasts, NHFC experienced a productive 2018 regarding organizational changes. We not only streamlined our online software database program to keep you informed, but also built and launched two new user-friendly websites. Visit your new website at https://nationalhealthfreedom.org, to stay updated through an educational resource center, a media page, and a new donation page that allows for recurring donations to support our ongoing work.

Our biggest priorities for 2019, as always, are protecting your inherent rights. As an increasingly hostile media writes a narrative that undermines healthy people who make healthful choices, new proposed mandates attempt to legislate the freedom to choose. At the same time, federal government has begun to censor communications in all media, including social media. And State governments are introducing bills nationwide that remove non-medical vaccine exemptions, as well as bills that restrict or remove parental choice. NHFC continues to assist Minnesota, California, and other states, legally, to protect parental rights.

Director Diane Miller, and staff attorney Anne Gillum continue to educate and promote "safe harbor" exemption state laws for homeopaths, naturopaths, and herbalists in several states, as well as protecting the rights of all consumers to choose non-toxic health options. Four states introduced legislation this session: Iowa, Maine, Massachusetts, and Wisconsin.

Finally, in response to the FDA draft guidance restrictions on homeopathic remedies, Diane Miller is in contact with the homeopathic community and has collaborated with California Health Freedom Coalition to draft legislation for discussion using a health freedom approach that ensures access and distribution to consumers of the widest range of homeopathic remedies, while also relieving smaller manufacturers of red-tape. It is time to reclaim the narrative.

Health Freedom Challenges

Promoting freedom of choice And access to health care choices

Barriers to Health Freedom

Many consumers have lost access to the health care options of their choice for healing. NHFC educates citizens as to why these events happen and what they can do about it.

- Licensed Practitioners practicing holistic approaches can lose their licenses for practicing outside of
 prevailing and accepted standards of care. Other practitioners, such as herbalists, homeopaths,
 traditional naturopaths and energy workers, can be prosecuted for practicing a profession without a
 license.
- Government regulations and laws are blocking people's fundamental rights to make health care
 decisions. Parental decision-making rights are being denied when governments require children to
 be vaccinated before they go to daycare or school, or to undergo chemotherapy or other toxic
 treatments and procedures against parental wishes.
- Quality of food and protection of the land and natural resources is jeopardized. Organic food standards are being challenged and the danger of genetically modified foods is being covered up.
- Farmers selling fresh produce from the farm are being raided. Food sovereignty is in danger.

NHFC Educating for Positive Change

NHFC raises awareness of what health freedom is and what needs to do be done to protect it. We support citizens in **forming state health freedom groups** and train them on how to participate in the legislative process to make the changes they want. NHFC receives a broad range of requests from citizens, including: help in understanding legislative bills; where to turn if a practitioner has been shut down for practicing a healing art; how to become active when a person's right to decline vaccines, or their right to obtain organic and non-genetically modified foods or fresh raw milk from a farm, or their right to parent their child without intervention from Child Protective Services has been jeopardized; and much more.

Health Freedom Work in 2018

National Health Freedom Coalition Moving Forward Toward Health Freedom in 2018!

NHFC was on the road in 2018, teaching about health freedom, and what citizens can do to protect and extend their

freedoms. Rosanne Lindsay, President of NHFC, spoke at the Southeastern Wise Woman Herbal Conference, about the fact that herbalists, as well as many other practitioners, are at risk of being prosecuted for the practice of a health care profession without a license. Jerri Johnson, NHFC Public Relations Coordinator, shared information at the American Herbalist Guild Symposium. They let herbalists know that NHFC's sister lobbying organization, National Health Freedom Action (NHFA), is working to pass practitioner exemption safe harbor laws, which give many practitioners exemptions from professional practice acts. Today, ten states have some form of safe harbor law that ensures that consumers can access a wide array of holistic practitioners.

Sally Tamplin, Vice President of NHFA, and Jerri Johnson, attended the Joint American Homeopathic Conference, discussing with homeopathic leaders homeopaths' right to practice and the importance of the practitioner exemption safe harbor bills. Jerri also spoke at the annual Minnesota Homeopathic Association conference.

Homeopathy was challenged in 2018 because the FDA introduced a Draft Guidance Document entitled

"Drug Products Labeled as Homeopathic for FDA Staff and Industry". NHFC has a strong interest in protecting access to homeopathic remedies, so it leaped into action, researching the laws of homeopathic remedies and supporting NHFA in its formal response to the FDA.

Parents' rights to make choices about their childrens' health has be-

come a huge issue in the health freedom movement, with governments and corporations attempting to coerce or mandate recommendations for treatments. Anne Gillum, attorney with NHFC and NHFA, Jerri Johnson, and Rosanne Lindsay

attended the Autism One Conference where the parental right to make choices about vaccinations and children's health was a key topic. NHFC educated about the importance of conscientious, philosophical and religious exemptions from government recommended vaccines, and about the importance of keeping these options available for parents in every state. In addition, Rosanne Lindsay participated in a panel on vaccines at the Trinity Conference. NHFC educates constantly

about the importance of ensuring that parents be able to make medical decisions for their children, including regarding their diet, chronic illness treatments, cancer treatments, vaccinations, and much more.


