Dear Friends of Health Freedom,

On behalf of the Board of the National Health Freedom Coalition (NHFC), I thank you for your generous support over the last year as we continue the work to protect health freedom for all Americans during times of imbalance and uncertainty.

In 2022, Americans saw the dissolution of illegal mandates for masking, medical testing, and vaccines, state by state. Yet, some medical doctors who failed to follow strict CDC COVID policies lost their licenses. While global leaders under G20 agreed that digital IDs and COVID vaccines should be required for all international travel, the people got busy protecting health freedom where they live. NHFC was there to assist.

Staff and attorneys at NHFC educated leaders in many state groups, not only on how to understand the legislative process, but also providing them with model legislation.

In September, NHFC hosted the 13th US Health Freedom Congress in Minnesota, bringing together 38 Health Freedom organizations and and many additional leaders to collaborate and pass resolutions on topics from genetic privacy to EMF radiation. Scott Tips, of the National Health Federation gave the Congress keynote.

NHFC took the health freedom message on the road in 2022 to: the Trinity Health Freedom Expo in Tinley Park, Illinois; Hippocrates Wellness in Palm Beach, Florida; Health and Freedom Summit in Nashville, Tennessee; The Children's Health Defense Conference in Knoxville, Tennessee; and the Natural Living Expo in Marlboro, Massachusetts. NHFC also spread the message of health freedom via the Robert Scott Bell Show, and on CHD. TV's The Solution, with Tony O'Donnell.

With continued attempts by global organizations to usurp individual rights and freedoms, NHFC is here to hold the vision for a truly free America where your right to access services and your right to choose is protected. National Health Freedom Coalition stands against medical mandates and holds a vision for an America where all people make their own health decisions in an environment free of coercion!

While 2022 saw continued attempts to infringe on our rights to make decisions about our own healthcare, NHFC is more determined than ever to work to protect our freedoms.

In spite of many great wins for health freedom in courts across the country, many healthcare workers, teachers, students, firefighters, police officers, our military, state employees and many others are still being faced with coercive tactics aimed at getting them to acquiesce to medical mandates against their will.

As NHFC teaches citizens and groups across the country how to impact health freedom public policy, we are seeing a big surge in the number of people stepping up and getting involved.

NHFC attorneys meet with many groups, coaching them on how to participate in the legislative process. We have responded to requests from Massachusetts, California, Vermont, Illinois, Ohio, Alabama, Oregon and more. Some citizens are concerned with practitioner rights to practice the healing arts. Other groups are concerned about mandates surrounding Covid. Once a group is ready to move forward, they often decide to pass a bill. That is the point where NHFC's sister lobbying organization, NHFA, steps in and works with the group to move legislation. NHFC provides legislative research on bills in all 50 states and in the federal government on health freedom.

PROTECTING THE FUTURE OF HEALTH FREEDOM





We are a country of laws, and thus it matters what our laws say! NHFC attorneys are experts at visioning new legislation that adequately protects our inalienable rights as humans on the planet.

Practitioner Right to Practice - Today, eleven states have safe harbor practitioner exemption laws in place that ensure both the right to practice and consumer access to herbalists, homeopaths, health coaches, and many others. We are hearing from people all over the country saying, "We want to do this in our state!" Currently, Oregon, Connecticut, and Massachusetts have groups working on similar policies. We were excited when Wisconsin's Complementary and Alternative Practices bill successfully passed through the full Assembly and Senate - but disappointed to see it vetoed by Governor Evers.

Right to Decline Emergency Countermeasures

The Righttorefuse.org website supports the constitutional right of each person to decline countermeasures such as testing, tracking and vaccination during a health emergency. 2022 showed amazing gains in the number of states getting involved in protecting their rights:



Between 2020 and the end of 2022:

47 states filed protective RTR bills
780+ RTR bills were filed over the past 2 years
27 states passed at least one Right to Refuse bill
70+ Right to Refuse bills passed into law!



2022 Health Freedom Congress

Friday September 21, 2022 the 38
Congress voting member organizations took their seats in the Congress circle as additional attendees seated in the surround. Each organization presented their mission and seven proposed resolutions that were lively discussed during the day.

The Congress was held in wireless free spaces with routers turned off and attendees phones off. Camilla Rees of ElectromagneticHealth.org presented about the dangers of wireless radiation.



The Right to Refuse project leaders presented on their efforts to work collaboratively with states across the nation to draft and file protective health freedom legislation that will protect bodily autonomy without coercion or discrimination.

A panel discussion with Robert Scott Bell, Ty and Charlene Bollinger and Stephanie Locricchio discussed their experiences, challenges, successes, and methods they use to pierce the veil of indoctrination and overcome censorship. The Robert Scott Bell Show broadcasted live from the Congress.

Friday night included an original music performance by Lori B. Williams performing her freedom song "We Are The Product They're Planning To Use"; Wil and Carly Crombie of Organic Compound presented on Community Powered Regenerative Agriculture; and Jennifer Sharp, film maker, director, editor, and writer, offered a premiere screening of her film Anecdotals.

Saturday was dedicated to Open Space small and large group discussions and visioning led by facilitator Denise Lewis Premschak.



The Congress culminated Saturday night in a beautiful organic Health Freedom Awards Banquet with Attorney Scott Tips JD, President, National Health Federation as the Keynote address.

Safe Harbor Maine
